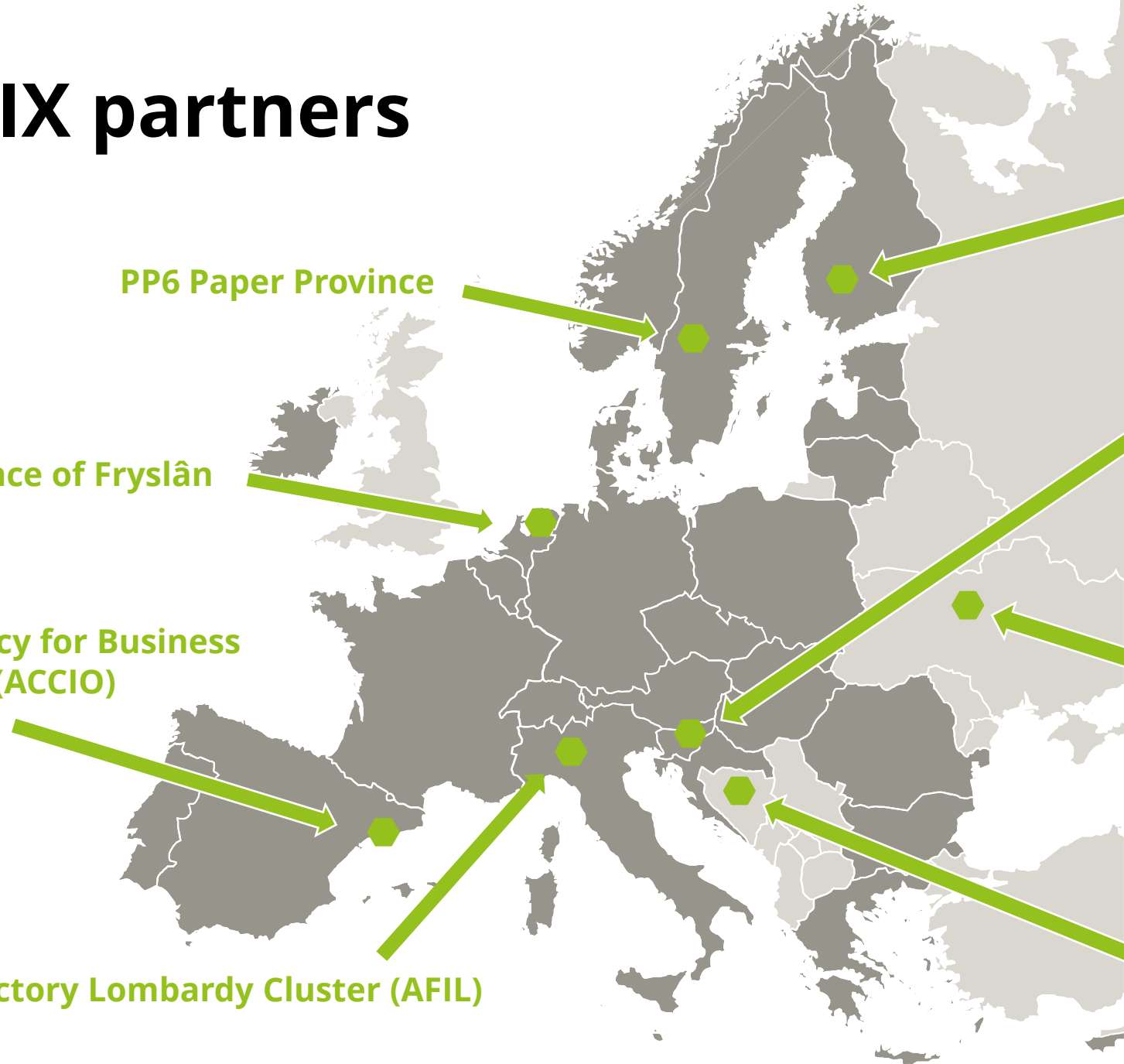

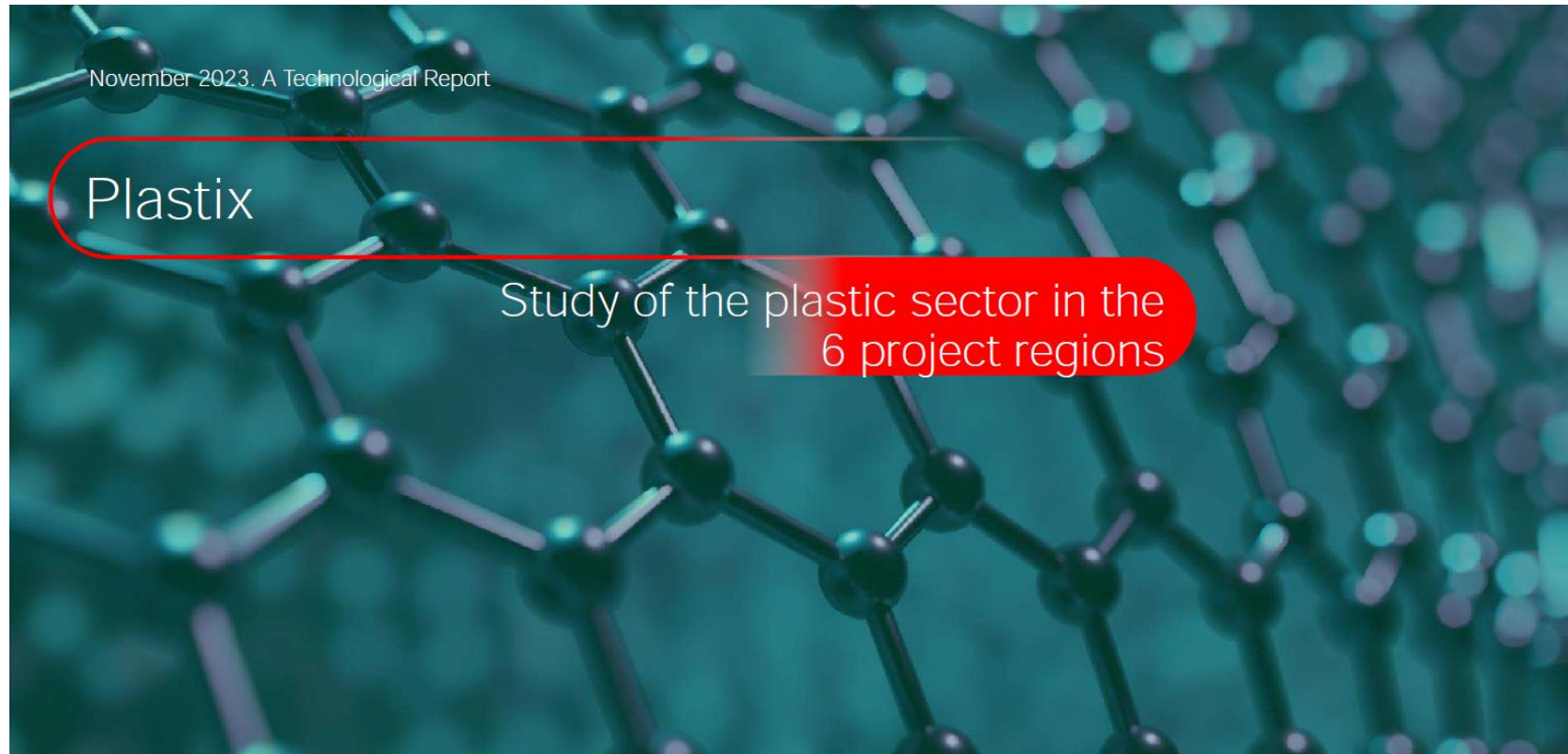
PLASTIX project objectives

Identify good practices and novel solutions through interregional exchange and co-creation to improve and create policy mechanisms which facilitate industrial transition towards a resource-efficient economy, and enhance more efficient plastic collection and recycling technologies and services.

Improve policy instruments to better enhance cooperation and exchange of practices between regional clusters and innovation actors throughout the EU improving the capacity of companies and research institutes to enter existing and new markets and to develop new plastic, biobased products and services based on the European Strategy for Plastics.

Through policy improvements, the project fosters eco-innovation of enterprises and SMEs to make plastics and plastic products easier to recycle, to support replacing single-use plastic with biobased materials, and to find new innovations in the field.

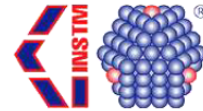

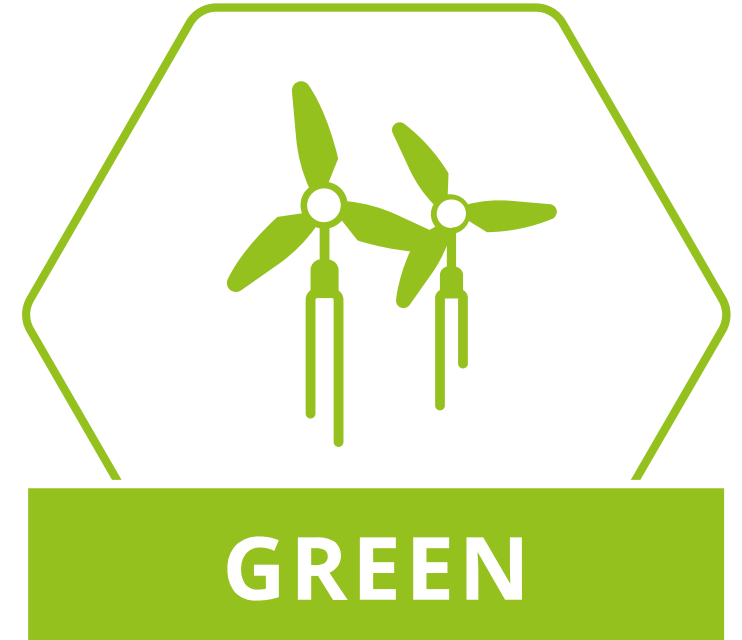
