Payment

Innovation Support V.
Validation Voucher

- Pre payment - 1st term
 - 50% once the action is approved for starting, within 30 days upon signature of the Grant Agreement.
- Final payment - 2nd term
 - 50% within 30 days upon approval of the financial and technical report.
 - In case the financial and technical report is not submitted and approved on time, the prepayment must be reimbursed to the VIDA coordinator.

Demonstration Voucher

-
- Payment - 1st term
 - 40% of the awarded voucher sum directly to the SME(s) within 30 days, once the milestone one (M1) Interim Report 1 is approved.
 - Payment – 2nd term
 - 40% of the awarded voucher sum directly to the SME(s) within 30 days, once the milestone two (M2) Interim Report 2 is approved.
 - Final payment - 3rd term
 - Milestone three (M3) Final Report is approved, within 30 days VIDA will pay the remaining costs incurred of the awarded voucher sum directly to the SME(s).

All payments will be made in Euro.
